

What is GIVE, With Love?

"GIVE, with love" is a fundraising outreach initiative by St Luke's ElderCare (SLEC) with the aim of reaching out to schools to fundraise and volunteer with us.

We hope this outreach will encourage our children to give generously to support elders in need.

Through the support from schools, we hope to raise \$200,000 through "GIVE, with love".

Why does SLEC need to raise funds urgently? During the circuit breaker, SLEC had to suspend our senior care centre services to reduce the risk of our elders contracting COVID-19. Close to 3,000 elders' daily lives were impacted.

Unfortunately, due to the suspension of services from April to June and waiver of fees for the elders, SLEC now needs to raise \$800,000 to cover the loss of income from the closure of centres.

Where will the funds raised go to?




What can your students do to help?

How to Set Up a Campaign in 5 mins?



1. Visit **www.giving.sg/slec**. *NVPC will be waiving its 3% transaction fees for all donations made through giving.sg from 1 January 2020 to 31 March 2021. St Luke's ElderCare will receive 100% of donations received through giving.sg.

2. Click "Fundraise Now"

3. Ensure your fundraising campaign page is set to "I'm fundraising for St Luke's ElderCare Ltd".


